COMMITTEE REPORTS

Fund Raising Committee

The Foundation was very successful in raising funds in 2011. Colorful Hoberman spheres were the table centerpieces that were auctioned off at the Annual Conference. BioMat, a Hawaii resort vacation, and a Chincoteague Island stay were some of the highlights of the live auction offerings. Continuing for the second consecutive year, special commemorative pop top charms were designed as a gift for donations of \$50 or more. The Foundation conducted raffles at HTP Regional Conferences in Cincinnati, New York, California, and Seattle. Board members and supporters of the Foundation are always working on securing valuable donation items for auctions and raffles.

Grant Committee

This year found this committee headed by 2 co-chairs, and 3 grant readers who helped to critique and make recommendations. The theme happened to be hospice centered, as the accepted grant proposals were Hospice by the Sea, Aloesea Caregiver Program Project in Florida, and the Masonic Village at Elizabethtown in Pennsylvania. The Florida program focused on providing Healing Touch sessions to its hospice caregivers, with accompanying evaluations of their well - being. The Masonic Village conducted a pilot program for other Masonic Villages, providing Level 1 Healing Touch training to hospice staff. Our total disbursement of funds in 2011 totaled \$8,235.45, an increase of \$2,000.00 from the previous year.

Public Relations/Marketing Committee

Public Relations and Marketing continued to focus on the committee's vision and mission to excite people to contribute funds and be motivated to be active in the work of the Foundation. A webmaster was hired to keep the Foundation's website current. See htwfoundation.org. The Foundation contributed stories and articles and was represented in all issues of Energy Magazine and the monthly HTP Community News. There was increased participation in Facebook activity. The Healing Touch Worldwide Foundation is increasingly more visible especially at regional gatherings and the annual conference.

Bylaws, Policies and Procedures Committee

We made modifications to our Policies and Procedures to customize our voting and election issues as we generally meet in a teleconference mode; HTWF remains guided by Robert's Rules of order. The development of guidelines for the Nomination Committee was underway.
