Margaret Moga, PhD, HTI-P, Indiana University School of Medicine, reports that, "magnetic field activity during Healing Touch seems to reflect the emotions and biofields of the participants."



Dr. Monica Nebauer received funding from HTWF to pay for transcription of data from eight focus groups for her Healing Touch research conducted over a three month period in Grand Lake, Colorado, Chicago, and in Brisbane, Australia. "The purpose of my research project is to explore the experiences of Healing Touch practitioners' spiritual development and how they live out the philosophy underpinning HT in their daily lives and spiritual practices. The data analysis has produced deep, rich themes that tell absorbing stories of HT practitioners' development of their spirituality through their practice of Healing Touch over many years and in different places and countries."

Funding Service
